




WHAT IS REMOTE KEY INJECTION (RKI)?

All PAXSTORE users utilizing the public Marketplace receive 5 Remote Key Injections (RKI).

* Additional RKI credits may be purchased for \$49 each. *



RKI (Remote Key Injection) is the process of securely downloading a PIN or data encryption key to a payment terminal, eliminating the need for merchants to ship their devices to a certified third-party facility for local key injection (LKI). With RKI, keys can be remotely and securely injected using factory-installed certificates. These certificates give the terminal the authority to receive keys via RKI.

The RKI key enables the terminal to process card transactions. The terminal can be injected with the RKI key from PAXSTORE. If the key does not appear in the key list, please contact rkisupport@pax.us for assistance.

When a new RKI key is added to the server, the Key Exchange team completes the key ceremony with the key issuer. After the ceremony, the RKI team receives the key and uploads it to the server. Once the key is on the server, the Acquirer or ISO must email rkisupport@pax.us with details about which marketplace the key should be made available for. If this step is not completed, the key will remain inaccessible.
